

**L3 PROJECT NAME:** Medicine and vocational training materials for sickle cell patients at State Hospital

**LOCATION:** Ijebu-Ode

**Summary:** Patients with sickle cell anemia are currently being provided monthly service at clinics where they receive education concerning their condition, blood building drugs, and lab work. Because most of these patients are fragile



from their disease, many occupations are not suited for them, therefore the Rotary club is seeking a partner to help support (1) drugs for 300 sickle cell clients in Ijebu-Ode and (2) appropriate vocational training for 80 sickle cell patients so the they are able to earn a living and provide for their families.
