

**L7 PROJECT NAME:** Materials for Rotary Wheel School (children of beggars)

**LOCATION:** Ikoyi-Obalende, Lagos

**Rotary Club of:** Falamo

**Summary:** The Rotary Club of Falamo started a school in the community for children of beggars in an attempt to break the cycle of poverty.

The school is named THE WHEEL SCHOOL and the club has completed the renovation of a block of five classrooms. They are seeking support in providing educational materials, teaching aids, new school uniforms and sandals, and payment of teacher salaries to continue the work of the school, which is growing in number of pupils and number of classes. For the current school year, 143 students are being served.
