

L9 PROJECT NAME: Safe drinking water for four villages in Ewekoro Local Government

LOCATION: Ogun State

Rotary Club of: Gbagada South

Summary: Otuga-Ade, Tekona, Seriki, and Oke-Odo are four neighboring villages in the Ewekoro Local Government area of Ogun State. Each village of approximately 250 inhabitants lacks electricity and good drinking water. Presently the source of drinking water is a stream. About 25% of the inhabitants of these villages suffer from river-blindness due to the contaminated water they consume. This project will provide two boreholes that would serve all four villages efficiently, 2 overhead tanks, and a generating set to power the pumping machine.
