PROJECT NAME: Construction of one Borehole +/- 60 meters deep

LOCATION: Tsamiya Babba Village
(In Gezawa Local Government area)
25 minutes east of Kano



Rotary Club of: Kano - Nassarawa

Summary: The borehole will be used to supply water for a projected dispensary to be erected in the village of Tsamiya Babba. It will serve the needs of approximately 100,000 villagers living in the eleven villages of this local government area. The dispensary can not be built without access to water year-round. The present well is functional only when the rains are heavy enough, and is otherwise dry.

The area lacks primary health care services with villagers needing to travel to Kano for all levels of medical care. Land for building the dispensary and borehole has been donated by a Kano Rotarian.

Project Budget:

US \$25,000.00 for one borehole well with motorized pump with funding for the dispensary to be sought upon financing of the borehole.
