PROJECT NAME: L.E.A. Primary School, Nassarawa 11, Kaduna

LOCATION: Chikun local government area, Kujama (Kaduna)

Rotary Club of: Kaduna

## Summary:

Children, ages 3-7, attend school daily without having writing desks/chairs, writing supplies or books. They sit quietly on their rugs on concrete floors, approximately 30 children per class and four classes per building. Desks can be built locally and will be branded with the Rotary logo and delivered by Rotarians within two weeks of commissioning the order. When Rotarians provide funds for desks, books, and basic educational materials (i.e., paper/pencils), young children are more likely to stay in school, receive an education, and reduce the poverty which leaves them without a future.



## Project Budget:

Materials sent from the US allows clubs/districts to "adopt" a school or a building of four classrooms. It should be noted that the Nassarawa Primary School is one of 15 schools in the District, and there are 44 Districts in Kaduna. Needs can be subdivided with Clubs doing classroom partnerships. Larger projects (i.e., latrines, water) can be built from smaller matching grant projects.
