Summary: The existing pit latrine was built in 1964 and has become unusable. Thus, the pupils defecate around the school premises, making it unsanitary and unsafe for the students to attend school. The tube well will compliment the latrine and will enhance the general sanitation. Many classrooms do not have desks. Students sitting on cement floors for school are sitting in very unsanitary conditions. Girl students usually quit attending school at age 9 or 10 when there are no latrines.
